Students will also be introduced, through case studies, to the limitations and potential of video through analysis. Students will be shown where resources can be found for video analysis tools, training, and trouble shooting advice.

- Be introduced to modern digital CCTV technology.
- Have an opportunity to work with each class of DVR.
