



Level 4: Advanced Forensic Video Analysis & the Law

Who Is It For: Graduates of all of the following: LEVA Level 1 and 2 and Level 3 courses.

Course Overview: This course is primarily hands-on in which students process video evidence, write a report and present it in a moot court. Perfecting the Curriculum Vitae is also featured. This 40-hour advanced level of instruction focuses on case law and relevant issues as well as advanced forensic video analysis techniques. There is considerable discussion of the legal issues surrounding the seizure and examination of digital CCTV images. Grading will be based on practicals throughout the week, a written exam and the moot court.

Objectives:

1. On own, process video evidence from provided case content
2. Write a report
3. Present case exemplar in a moot court.
