Payments

To secure your booking, payment must either be received with the completed booking form or with a company purchase order. Please note that your organisation must be set up on our accounting system for bill back facilities. All invoices are payable within 30 days.

Acceptable methods of payment include credit card/debit card or bank transfer. Please note that International Bank Transfers are not permitted.

Cancellation by the sponsor

Exhibitors wishing to cancel a booking must do so in writing to nicola.schumacher@csofs.org at the Society. Receipt of such a request will be confirmed in writing. In the event of a cancellation request, the following charges will apply:

- 30% of total cost if cancelled more than 4 - 6 weeks prior to first day of the conference.
- 60% of total cost if cancelled between 2 - 4 weeks prior to the day of the conference.
- The full cost of the booking is payable for cancellations less than 2 weeks prior to the day of the conference.

Conference cancellation or postponement by The Chartered Society of Forensic Sciences

The Society do not accept any liability for losses incurred in the event of the conference being cancelled or postponed due to an unforeseen event or any other event that renders the continuation of this conference inadvisable, illegal, impracticable or impossible. An unforeseen event shall include, but shall not be limited to: an Act of God; infectious disease outbreak; service provider failures; war or apparent act of war; terrorism or apparent act of terrorism; disaster; civil disorder, disturbance, and/or riots; curtailment, suspension, and/or restriction on transportation; or any other emergency. In the event the conference is cancelled no refunds will be issued. All available funds, after cancellation expenses, will be credited towards rescheduling a future conference at a later date.

Bankruptcy
