**Clive Driscoll, Retired Detective Chief Inspector, Metropolitan Police Service - 7pm**

Retired on 31st May 2014 after completing over 33 years exemplary service with the Metropolitan Police Service. Clive retired as a Detective Chief Inspector and investigated as the Senior Investigating Officer on several high-profile cases obtaining two convictions in the Stephen Lawrence murder. He became the first police officer to obtain a conviction in an Honour Based Violence murder where no body has ever been found. Clive's book "**In Pursuit of the Truth**" was published in July 2016.



**Dr Richard Shepherd, Retired Forensic Pathologist - 9pm**

Dr Shepherd was a Forensic pathologist for nearly 40 years as a Consultant and Senior Lecturer in Forensic Medicine until he retired in 2016. He has also sat on a number of government advisory boards. He was the forensic expert for the 9/11 and Bali bombings, the Bloody Sunday Inquiry and for the Inquest into the death of Diana, Princess of Wales. His autobiography "**Unnatural Causes**" was published in September 2018.
